

# The Persecution of Christ Brothers

The persecution of Christ Brothers is not a subject often addressed by the main-stream religions of our world, not unless, they are put upon in a manner that causes them discomfort such as being criticized for what is being done in the name of religion by people without same religious conviction.

This is coined “religious persecution” and is referred too often as what Christ Jesus suffered, and which he then told his brothers they would also suffer. But is this what Jesus Christ himself was referring to, and more importantly was this the type of persecution he suffered in his flesh while on earth?

When a person addresses Jesus Christ while on earth by a physical understanding they cannot correctly define what Christ Jesus life and minister was about. “Physical” in this case is ignoring the obvious teachings that all in Christ Jesus life was led by Spirit, and all within his brothers lives were also Spirit led. When God's written word refers to a “physical person” it is stating the person is “fleshly” under sin condemned by God's righteous judgment through the Old Law.

***John 6:63 It is the spirit who gives life. The flesh profits nothing. The words that I speak to you are spirit, and are life.***

***Romans 3:20 Because by the works of the law, no flesh will be justified in his sight. For through the law comes the knowledge of sin.***

Without this basic understand of how we know God and Christ Jesus, which is by Holy Spirit, one cannot understand what type of persecution Christ brothers were too suffer. Thus, there are two groups according to God's word, those in Christ Jesus, and those of the world, or not in Christ Jesus.

***John 3:5 Jesus answered, "Most certainly I tell you, unless one is born of water and spirit, he can't enter into the Kingdom of God!***

***3:6 That which is born of the flesh is flesh. That which is born of the Spirit is spirit.***

When Christ Jesus was raised into heaven after his death in his flesh he became a mighty Spirit person sitting at the right hand of His Father Jehovah God, who is also a Spirit person. He was given incorruptible life, which is immortal life, as a Spiritual person. So everything affecting a Christian's life concerning Jesus Christ is then also spiritual.

***John 3:6 That which is born of the flesh is flesh. That which is born of the Spirit is spirit.***

These in Christ Jesus have become a new creation, a new personality, with a new heart, all by the power of God's Holy Spirit creating in them through Christ Jesus a Spiritual person. Christ brothers as well have been made a part of the Spiritual body of Christ Jesus; in so being they have been raised with Christ Jesus into the Spiritual heavens.

***2 Corinthians 5:17 Therefore if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation. The old things have passed away. Behold, all things have become new.***

***Colossians 2:12 having been buried with him in baptism, in which you were also raised with him through faith in the working of God, who raised him from the dead.***

Moreover, since they a part of the body of Christ Jesus they are also the Spiritual Temple of God, because Christ Jesus is God's Temple, and he is a Spirit person.

***1 Corinthians 9:13 Don't you know that those who serve around sacred things eat from the things of the temple, and those who wait on the altar have their portion with the altar?***

Subsequently, they are led by God's Holy Spirit, that is, being a member of the Spiritual body of Christ Jesus such a one has to be led by God's Holy Spirit not by physical things such as books, teachings, doctrines, groups. law, or lust of their own flesh in the world.

When one understands these basic teachings of Christ Jesus they can draw a correct spiritual understanding of how Christ brothers are persecuted as Christ Jesus himself was persecuted while upon earth in his flesh.

**1Pet.4:1 Forasmuch then as Christ suffered for us in the flesh, arm yourselves also with the same mind; for he who has suffered in the flesh has ceased from sin;**

*1Pet.4:12 Beloved, don't be astonished at the fiery trial which has come upon you, to test you, as though a strange thing happened to you.*

*4:13 But because you are partakers of Christ's sufferings, rejoice; that at the revelation of his glory you also may rejoice with exceeding joy.*

There is no greater persecution in a person life then suffering and not know why they are suffering? Much more so, when suffering at the hands of those claiming to know the sufferings of Christ Jesus, thus, correcting a person with untruths , that is not by Holy Spirit. This is the equivalent of stating that the person has brought the persecution upon themselves, or that they have a persecution complex, and worst yet; God Himself is displeased with them, and their persecution is proof of secret sins.

*Proverbs 12:6 The words of the wicked are about lying in wait for blood, but the speech of the upright rescues them.*

### **Persecution Started With Man's Sin**

God was clear from the start of sin entering into our world through Adam, that persecution would be part of the lives of those loving Him.

*Gen.3:15 I will put enmity between you and the woman, and between your offspring and her offspring. He will bruise your head, and you will bruise his heel."*

Here the stage was set for the history of God's people upon earth, that is, a war would exist between two seeds, one born of God, and one born of sin; a war would rage between the Spirit and the Flesh, these two seeds, just as God had said.

Thus, this is key to understanding the persecution of Christ Jesus brothers.

*1 Peter 3:18 Because Christ also suffered for sins once, the righteous for the unrighteous, that he might bring you to God; being put to death in the flesh, but made alive in the spirit;*

***Galatians 5:17 For the flesh lusts against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh; and these are contrary to one another, that you may not do the things that you desire.***

A person cannot see Holy Spirit, so they can only judge its fruits, but on the other hand, the “spiritual world” sees clearly with understands God's Spirit, because it's eyes are spiritual and not physical eyes like ours. Where a Christian sees with their physical eyes the persecution of Christ brothers it will be misunderstood, thus, the person will become the problem instead of God's encouragement in strengthening the faith of their brothers with His Holy Spirit increasing their faith to stand against wicked spirit force in heavenly places.

***2Cor.1:21 Now he who establishes us with you in Christ, and anointed us, is God;***

***1:22 who also sealed us, and gave us the down payment of the Spirit in our hearts.***

***2 Timothy 4:22 The Lord Jesus Christ be with your spirit. Grace be with you. Amen.***

***Hebrews 2:4 God also testifying with them, both by signs and wonders, by various works of power, and by gifts of the Holy Spirit, according to his own will?***

Christ brothers are clearly marked with the Spirit of God because they are created by it, this mark is read by the spirit world, which, they have become a part of, by God's Holy Spirit; even though they live in their flesh on earth. For a brother of Christ Jesus to interpret his persecution through physical doctrines instead of the truth is a huge mistake, for they are a theatrical spectacle too this spirit world; which they resides as the temple of God; this mistake is death dealing too their faith.

***1 Peter 4:14 If you are insulted for the name of Christ, you are blessed; because the Spirit of glory and of God rests on you. On their part he is blasphemed, but on your part he is glorified.***

***1Cor. 3:3 for you are still fleshly. For insofar as there is jealousy, strife, and factions among you, aren't you fleshly, and don't you walk in the ways of men?***

***1Cor. 2:6 We speak wisdom, however, among those who are full grown; yet a wisdom not of this world, nor of the rulers of this world, who are coming to nothing.***

***2:7 But we speak God's wisdom in a mystery, the wisdom that has been hidden, which God foreordained before the worlds for our glory,***

Moreover, seeking the approval of men for understanding ones persecution in Christ Jesus is seeking physical eyes too comfort one in Spiritual suffering. The very truth that a brother of Christ suffering is unseen by the flesh is that which they have been called into for Christ Jesus. The glory of God is resting upon them unseen by those with fleshly eyes this marks them for attacks by the spirit world, which is knowingly in rebellion against God from the start of mankind on earth.

***2 Corinthians 3:17 Now the Lord is the Spirit and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is liberty.***

***2 Corinthians 10:3 For though we walk in the flesh, we don't wage war according to the flesh;***

***1 Corinthians 6:19 Or don't you know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit which is in you, which you have from God? You are not your own,***

***Ephesians 6:12 For our wrestling is not against flesh and blood, but against the principalities, against the powers, against the world's rulers of the darkness of this age, and against the spiritual forces of wickedness in the heavenly places.***

***1Cor.2:9 But as it is written, "Things which an eye didn't see, and an ear didn't hear, which didn't enter into the heart of man, these God has prepared for those who love him." {Isaiah 64:4}***

***2:10 But to us, God revealed them through the Spirit. For the Spirit searches all things, yes, the deep things of God.***

### **Fear of Unseen by The Flesh**

A Christian must understand fear is driven by something out of their control, the flesh demands control and in order to maintain its control, it creates concrete laws to protect itself from things out of its control. Christ Jesus brothers do not have this luxury, it is not part of them.

Christ brothers are depended upon their faith in God and nothing more, where they fight in physical ways to protect themselves they lose to the darkness of the spiritual wickedness in heaven places.

***Heb.11:33 who, through faith subdued kingdoms, worked out righteousness, obtained promises, stopped the mouths of lions,{Daniel 6:22-23}  
11:34 quenched the power of fire,{Daniel 3:1-30} escaped the edge of the sword,{1 Kings 19:1-3; 2 Kings 6:31-7:20} from weakness were made strong, grew mighty in war, and caused foreign armies to flee.***

***Rom.12:17 Repay no one evil for evil. Respect what is honorable in the sight of all men.***

***12:18 If it is possible, as much as it is up to you, be at peace with all men.***

Moreover, when they do not understand faith as trust in all that God does is good and from love they will fall into the trap and snare of the Devil for his will. Understanding that they are a live in Christ Jesus, and he is The Life takes the fear of death from them, that is, death is unseen and out of a humans control it is in God's hands, but it has been over come by Jesus who become life, and is now is our life because we are a part of him.

***James 1:13 Let no man say when he is tempted, "I am tempted by God," for God can't be tempted by evil, and he himself tempts no one.***

***Job 1:22 In all this, Job did not sin, nor charge God with wrongdoing.***

### **Walking by Faith and Not Sight**

Walking on water requires faith in Christ Jesus and his command too come to Peter. Peter was flesh and blood not spirit, thus, for him to walk on water all depended upon God's power and not from Peter; all Peter could offer was trust in Christ Jesus command, but not in his own power, or goodness to walk upon the stormy seas.

***James 1:16 Don't be deceived, my beloved brothers.***

***1:17 Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of lights, with whom can be no variation, nor turning shadow.***

Our spiritual battles requires just such a faith; it all depends upon God supplying us power beyond ourselves and what we offer up is trust in God that He will provide what ever we need at the correct time to over come the persecution.

***2 Corinthians 5:7 for we walk by faith, not by sight.***

All the wisdom required for our spiritual battles is found in our spiritual body of Christ Jesus. Which we have become a part of; our wisdom exist in the head of our spiritual body Jesus Christ; here rested all the wisdom of God.

***1 Corinthians 1:24 but to those who are called, both Jews and Greeks, Christ is the power of God and the wisdom of God.***

We must trust that Christ Jesus over came the world and became life, that life is in us and we in him. Although trials can lead to a physical death of our sinful flesh we have life in Christ Jesus.

***1 John 5:4 For whatever is born of God overcomes the world. This is the victory that has overcome the world: your faith.***

***1 John 5:11 The testimony is this, that God gave to us eternal life, and this life is in his Son.***

***1 John 5:12 He who has the Son has the life. He who doesn't have God's Son doesn't have the life.***

Moreover, Christ Jesus has defeated Satan, so nothing which befalls us is out of Christ Jesus control.

***Rev. 1:18 and the Living one. I was dead, and behold, I am alive forevermore. Amen. I have the keys of Death and of Hades{or, Hell}.***

### **No Fear in Love**

God is love, and there is no fear in love, fear resides in our flesh, and our flesh is under sins judgment. So it is easy for the flesh to reason that it is unworthy of God's love, and it is right! Guilt resides in sin and sin resides in us and this is why we must have the mind of Christ Jesus and not a fleshly mind, but why?

Because no sin reside in Christ Jesus, he is without guilt,he is The Life overcoming death and sin in us. The mark of God's Spirit resting upon us is God's glory not our own, we are mere vessels of God's glory empty of self-will and being made into a vessel of mercy for God's pleasure.

***Rom.9:22 What if God, willing to show his wrath, and to make his power known, endured with much patience vessels of wrath made for destruction, 9:23 and that he might make known the riches of his glory on vessels of mercy, which he prepared beforehand for glory,***

**John 17:2 even as you gave him authority over all flesh, he will give eternal life to all whom you have given him.**

**John 12:25 He who loves his life will lose it. He who hates his life in this world will keep it to eternal life.**

**John 11:25 Jesus said to her, "I am the resurrection and the life. He who believes in me will still live, even if he dies.**

God made Jesus Christ life he has no condemnation against him by law convicting him of sin, so guilt is not possible for him or in him. So Satan has no hold on him, thus, all those a part of Christ Jesus as his body members - Satan has no hold on them either, but why?

Simply put, Christ brothers are a part of life, Christ Jesus was rewarded life, and made life by his Father, he is sinless, and therefore law convicting sin has no power over him. Thus, Christ has power over life and death. Christ Jesus brothers are given his righteousness, not their own, as a gift of undeserved kindness by God's love. So while sufferings they are truly suffering for Christ, that is, his righteousness, and not their own righteousness.

***1Cor. 4:3 But with me it is a very small thing that I should be judged by you, or by man's judgment. Yes, I don't judge my own self.***

***4:4 For I know nothing against myself. Yet I am not justified by this, but he who judges me is the Lord.***

***4:5 Therefore judge nothing before the time, until the Lord comes, who will both bring to light the hidden things of darkness, and reveal the counsels of the hearts. Then each man will get his praise from God.***



Though they may sin in their flesh in such persecution it does not matter, why? Because their flesh and sins are accounted as dead in Christ Jesus, they are no more, so neither is there any condemnation by law against them.

***Romans 6:4 We were buried therefore with him through baptism to death, that just like Christ was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father, so we also might walk in newness of life.***

***Romans 6:11 Thus consider yourselves also to be dead to sin, but alive to God in Christ Jesus our Lord.***

Satan cannot conquer them with guilt the price has been paid and satisfied by God righteous standards for justice in the blood of Christ Jesus.

***Micah 7:18 Who is a God like you, who pardons iniquity, and passes over the disobedience of the remnant of his heritage? He doesn't retain his anger forever, because he delights in loving kindness.***

***7:19 He will again have compassion on us. He will tread our iniquities under foot; and you will cast all their sins into the depths of the sea.***

***1 John 3:20 because if our heart condemns us, God is greater than our heart, and knows all things.***

***1 Peter 3:4 but in the hidden person of the heart, in the incorruptible adornment of a gentle and quiet spirit, which is in the sight of God very precious.***

***Rom. 8:1 There is therefore now no condemnation to those who are in Christ Jesus, who don't walk according to the flesh, but according to the Spirit. {NU omits "who don't walk according to the flesh, but according to the Spirit"}***

***8:2 For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus made me free from the law of sin and of death.***

### **Putting on Christ Righteousness**

Knowing the truth is the putting on of Christ Jesus Righteousness, in doing so we understand the war against us.

We now know why others cannot see our suffering no matter how obvious it is to us not unless they are marked with the same Spirit of God, or it is God's will for the person too see, but it is never our will involved, not unless we get into a physical conflict with the person. Thus, forcing our rights on them, which is nothing more than standing in our righteousness, and not Christ Jesus.

***Rom.5:39 But I tell you, don't resist him who is evil; but whoever strikes you on your right cheek, turn to him the other also.***

***1Pet.3:9 not rendering evil for evil, or reviling for reviling; but instead blessing; knowing that to this were you called, that you may inherit a blessing.***

***3:10 For, "He who would love life, and see good days, let him keep his tongue from evil, and his lips from speaking deceit.***

By God's Spirit we recall that we are in an age old battle raging from the beginning of time, that the Kingdom of God will be taken by violence and the violence will done against us because of what we are marked with God's Spirit. Moreover, the world will see us as plagued and rejected by God this will add too our persecution as Christ Jesus own body experienced in his flesh.

***Matthew 11:12 From the days of John the Baptizer until now, the Kingdom of Heaven suffers violence, and the violent take it by force.{or, plunder it.}***

***Titus 3:5 not by works of righteousness, which we did ourselves, but according to his mercy, he saved us, through the washing of regeneration and renewing by the Holy Spirit,***

***Romans 8:10 If Christ is in you, the body is dead because of sin, but the spirit is alive because of righteousness.***

***1 Corinthians 1:30 But of him, you are in Christ Jesus, who was made to us wisdom from God, and righteousness and sanctification, and redemption:***

***Isa.53:3 He was despised, and rejected by men; a man of suffering, and acquainted with disease. He was despised as one from whom men hide their face; and we didn't respect him.***

***53:4 Surely he has borne our sickness, and carried our suffering; yet we considered him plagued, struck by God, and afflicted.***

***53:5 But he was pierced for our transgressions. He was crushed for our iniquities. The punishment that brought our peace was on him; and by his wounds we are healed.***

***53:6 All we like sheep have gone astray. Everyone has turned to his own way; and Yahweh has laid on him the iniquity of us all.***

### **Self-importance Impaled in Christ Jesus**

No human being could suffer in such a manner within their own will, but why? Simply put, the forces we are dealing with are superhuman and have lived thousands, perhaps, millions of years in the spirit world. Moreover, they hold various degrees of power in position within kingdoms of spiritual darkness.

Furthermore, all that is in Christ Jesus is about serving others in humility, and our humility is Christ Jesus because of his faithfulness to our Father Jehovah God. We are a part of him we are honored in being considered worthy to suffer for his righteousness, thus, suffering in the glory of God.

We are not suffering for our own goodness, or our works of goodness, if so we will give out, because we will not have the power of Christ Jesus sustaining us against this powerful spiritual battle raging in heaven against God's righteousness who is Christ Jesus, in which we are now a part of.

***Hebrews 12:3 For consider him who has endured such contradiction of sinners against himself, that you don't grow weary, fainting in your souls.***

Calling upon the name of Christ Jesus in times of trial is more than a “name” it is about all, which is spoken above, as our daily reality a part of our lives of spirit and truth. It is our faith that Christ Jesus exists in Kingdom Power, and that we are actually a part of his spiritual body upon earth and in heaven. He is not just a word repeated over and over again; he is “God's Word” and he is “The Life” in us, a life that powerfully overcame, and overcomes all in this world, which is working in us by light over darkness in victorious life, the life of Christ.

***Revelation 3:5 He who overcomes will be arrayed in white garments, and I will in no way blot his name out of the book of life, and I will confess his name before my Father, and before his angels.***

When we fall into self-importance we fall into sin and guilt, and will quickly be devoured by Satan the roaring lion, at these times God is faithful beyond our haughtiness, and self-will; He save us, but we will suffer loss.

***1Pet.5:6 Humble yourselves therefore under the mighty hand of God, that he may exalt you in due time;***

***5:7 casting all your worries on him, because he cares for you.***

***5:8 Be sober and self-controlled. Be watchful. Your adversary the devil, walks around like a roaring lion, seeking whom he may devour.***

***James 4:4 You adulterers and adulteresses, don't you know that friendship with the world is enmity with God? Whoever therefore wants to be a friend of the world makes himself an enemy of God.***

***4:5 Or do you think that the Scripture says in vain, "The Spirit who lives in us yearns jealously"?***

***4:6 But he gives more grace. Therefore it says, "God resists the proud, but gives grace to the humble." {Proverbs 3:34}***

***John 8:54 Jesus answered, "If I glorify myself, my glory is nothing. It is my Father who glorifies me, of whom you say that he is our God.***

***John 7:18 He who speaks from himself seeks his own glory, but he who seeks the glory of him who sent him is true, and no unrighteousness is in him.***

### **Persecution a Mark of Being in Christ Jesus**

Setting up rules defining persecution is child's play to the Holy Spirit, these rules will led us into spiritual shipwreck, and the destruction of our faith. Rules for persecution are for the flesh lacking faith in God; in trying to protect ourselves from the fear of suffering for the Christ Jesus. Moreover, claiming positive stories with happy endings, and material blessings are another foolish attempt to appease the flesh for a lack of godly endurance in Christ Jesus.

Christ brothers are in Life and have The Life indwelling in them, they receive the glory from suffering in Christ Jesus in their flesh, which produces more and more life, finally obtaining to a glorified position within Christ Jesus in the spiritual heavens.

This is their story with a happy ending in heaven in a glorified heavenly body. Anything beyond this is selling someone a bill of goods. Putting full trust in God's love and righteousness is the seal of our faith that He will only do good towards us and keep His words beyond this life into the next life; the same faith in us that Christ Jesus showed while upon earth.

***John 3:33 He who has received his witness has set his seal to this, that God is true.***

Although the things written aforementioned in the holy writings are for our instruction, but when twisted by those living for survival of their flesh they can mean the destruction of our faith. The big mistake Christian's make is when reading these stories of faith of God's faithful prophets in remembering these prophets were not part of life Christ as we are as Christian's in Christ Jesus. Subsequently, many of them did received material blessings for the remainder of their live in proving faithful to God.

But for those born of God's Holy Spirit in Christ Jesus they have received their reward while alive in their flesh in putting faith in Jesus Christ who has become life too us. They receive the Holy Spirit and it spiritual gifts exceeding any material gifts upon this earth. Moreover, being made a part of Christ Jesus we are now a part of his eternal life. We suffer in our flesh because we have received this unfathomable gift of undeserved kindness in Christ Jesus based on God's love, yes, love that God Himself expresses faith in that His love will not fail in our hearts.

***Romans 11:33 Oh the depth of the riches both of the wisdom and the knowledge of God! How unsearchable are his judgments, and his ways past tracing out!***

***Ephesians 1:18 having the eyes of your hearts{TR reads "understanding" instead of "hearts"} enlightened, that you may know what is the hope of his calling, and what are the riches of the glory of his inheritance in the saints.***

This angers Satan more than anything else, so he does all in his power to destroy our faith in God's love in hopes we loose are heavenly calling. Our hope cannot be destroyed by Satan, provided we walk in love, the love inscribed into our hearts at our anointing. Christ promised he would send the helper the Holy Spirit to remind us of all thing in love written into our hearts.

***Matt.26:38 Then he said to them, "My soul is exceedingly sorrowful, even to death. Stay here, and watch with me."***

***26:39 He went forward a little, fell on his face, and prayed, saying, "My Father, if it is possible, let this cup pass away from me; nevertheless, not what I desire, but what you desire."***

***Philippians 4:7 And the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and your thoughts in Christ Jesus.***

### **Living For The City Having Real Foundation**

Living for the New Jerusalem above means walking on water each day where a raging seas of flesh from within and outside ourselves wants us to sink our vessel into self-justification. This battle is unseen by human eyes, and is mask by our own flesh bearing up our burden so we are not one too others.

The flesh wants short term rewards and demands it when being tried by the spiritual world, but everything within God's word points to us waiting in patience to obtain the long range goal of gaining the city having real foundation.

***Heb 13:14 For here we have no fixed resting-place, but our search is for the one which is to come.***

***Psalms 27:14 Wait for Yahweh. Be strong, and let your heart take courage. Yes, wait for Yahweh.***

***Job 35:14 How much less when you say you don't see him. The cause is before him, and you wait for him!***

***James 5:7 Be patient therefore, brothers, until the coming of the Lord. Behold, the farmer waits for the precious fruit of the earth, being patient over it, until it receives the early and late rain.***

Without this mind-set a Christian will not stay the course in their spiritual battles with darkness. Looking to others even in the bible to demand from God what is fair and unfair in our daily trials only leads us to bitter disappointments and more rejection by others. In other words, the example in the holy writings our examples of persons faith under trials, which are not laws, rules, or doctrines, faith is not a tangible items defined by law, no more so in Peter walking upon water.

***Rom.12:6 Having gifts differing according to the grace that was given to us, if prophecy, let us prophesy according to the proportion of our faith;***

***Rom.10:11 For the Scripture says, "Whoever believes in him will not be disappointed." {Isaiah 28:16}***

***Rom.9:15 For he said to Moses, "I will have mercy on whom I have mercy, and I will have compassion on whom I have compassion." {Exodus 33:19}***  
***9:16 So then it is not of him who wills, nor of him who runs, but of God who has mercy.***

### **Looking to The Faith of Our Lord**

Faith is trust, trust out love for the person it is given, which is in our case, love for God, and love has no laws against it. Those under the weight of the primary doctrines of the Christ see in these faithful examples of the prophets concrete rules, such as the story of Job, and his happy ending in gaining many material and physical blessings.

When this does not happen for them an immature Christian becomes bitterly disappointed blaming God, even-though at the same time denying all the other examples of God's faithful prophets who died because of their faith. Choosing instead the ones with a happy material ending.

***Rom.9:19 You will say then to me, "Why does he still find fault? For who withstands his will?"***

***9:20 But indeed, O man, who are you to reply against God? Will the thing formed ask him who formed it, "Why did you make me like this?" {Isaiah 29:16; 45:9}***

Faith in God, that is, Abraham's faith, who is called the father of our faith was much different than even Abraham could have ever imagined; he trust in God was tested beyond human thought. Abraham waited God's promise into old age almost 100-years of age, his wife was long past bearing children, all hope in human ability was taken from both of them in producing an offspring of their marriage, and yet God showed that nothing within human thinking was needed for Him to keep His promise to Abraham.

*Isa.40:5 The glory of Yahweh shall be revealed, and all flesh shall see it together; for the mouth of Yahweh has spoken it."*

*40:6 The voice of one saying, "Cry!" One said, "What shall I cry?" "All flesh is like grass, and all its glory is like the flower of the field.*

*40:7 The grass withers, the flower fades, because Yahweh's breath blows on it. Surely the people are like grass.*

*40:8 The grass withers, the flower fades; but the word of our God stands forever."*

*40:14 Who did he take counsel with, and who instructed him, and taught him in the path of justice, and taught him knowledge, and showed him the way of understanding?*

*40:15 Behold, the nations are like a drop in a bucket, and are regarded as a speck of dust on a balance. Behold, he lifts up the islands like a very little thing.*

We can legalize this beautiful story of God promise and love for Abraham, but it would be as foolish as saying; "God gave Abraham what he wanted so he must give me what I want". This is the mind-set of law, it demands love and demands God to act the same way in each and every case of His love. This type of thinking is childish, and immature which is nothing more then the primary doctrines of the Christ Jesus.

Love has no laws against it, and God is love, what God hopes for each of us is our love will grow for Him, not a selfish love, but a love that trust Him in every aspect of His being in our lives.

God teaches us that love is life, and when we are perfected in love we obtain the eternal life given us by shedding our sinful fleshly body. God could not bring us to a lesser quality than love, for He is love.



***Deuteronomy 10:12 Now, Israel, what does Yahweh your God require of you, but to fear Yahweh your God, to walk in all his ways, and to love him, and to serve Yahweh your God with all your heart and with all your soul,***

***1 Corinthians 13:2 If I have the gift of prophecy, and know all mysteries and all knowledge; and if I have all faith, so as to remove mountains, but don't have love, I am nothing.***

***1 Corinthians 13:13 But now faith, hope, and love remain--these three. The greatest of these is love.***

The persecution of Christ brothers is about perfecting love in us, and without suffering in Christ Jesus we cannot be perfected in love for our Father Jehovah God, but why?

***Philippians 1:29 Because it has been granted to you on behalf of Christ, not only to believe in him, but also to suffer on his behalf.***

***1 Timothy 4:10 For to this end we both labor and suffer reproach, because we have set our trust in the living God, who is the Savior of all men, especially of those who believe.***

***Revelation 2:10 Don't be afraid of the things which you are about to suffer. Behold, the devil is about to throw some of you into prison, that you may be tested; and you will have oppression for ten days. Be faithful to death, and I will give you the crown of life.***

### **Purpose for Suffering in Christ Jesus**

***Heb. 5:7 He, in the days of his flesh, having offered up prayers and petitions with strong crying and tears to him who was able to save him from death, and having been heard for his godly fear,***

***5:8 though he was a Son, yet learned obedience by the things which he suffered.***

***Romans 8:29 For whom he foreknew, he also predestined to be conformed to the image of his Son, that he might be the firstborn among many brothers.{The word for "brothers" here and where context allows may also be correctly translated "brothers and sisters" or "siblings."}***

Most immature Christian's believe Christ Jesus suffered so he would obey God's law's closers, this is false, Christ Jesus lived under the law perfectly, and willingly fulfilled the Old Law setting it aside. Christ Jesus exceeded the righteousness of the Scribes and Pharisees in loving His Father under law. Christ learned obedience in suffering and perfecting his faith in God's love not in obeying the Old Law, obeying law is nothing more than a perfunctory obligation. Many people obey rules with no thought of love for the creators or the enforce of them.

All laws of God our valueless unless they are translated into love, the process of suffering in the Christ is translates us into love through suffer under sins law.

***Colossians 1:13 who delivered us out of the power of darkness, and translated us into the Kingdom of the Son of his love;***

Obedience as taught by group doctrine is obedience to their rules, or perhaps the principle of the Old Law. But for Christ brothers it is obedience in love.

Christ Jesus obeyed God in this manner, he obeyed because he loved His Father, he did not obey because the Law would punish him for not obeying. Christ Jesus wanted to obey out love with his whole heart, mind, and soul, because he was sinless he would not of had to work in obeying God's righteous laws it was as natural as a fish in the water with little or not thought, like Adam and Eve, but to love God in suffering now that is a whole other story that even the angels of God had not learned, in which Christ Jesus did so perfectly.

***Matthew 22:37 Jesus said to him, "'You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind.'*{Deuteronomy 6:5}**

Abraham obey God command to kill his own son because he had come to know God as a loving Father. Abraham did not say:

“Your law commands me not to murder so I will disobey your command for me to kill my son”. No Abraham could not think evil of God, so he obeyed what he did not understand according to human thinking, or even the interpretation of God's law by humans understanding.

Thus, when obedience is done for love of God we have perfected our faith in God. Our leader and teachers is translating us into love through our suffering in his body. This is why it is foolish for us to define what we may suffer or may not suffer by rules.

What is far superior and better is suffering and believing God is good in allowing suffering to come upon us whatever that may be. Thus, our suffering under these condition are perfecting our faith in God's love; we are not saying here we have no faith, but rather perfecting our faith means sanctifying our every thought into perfect holiness regarding God's love. Yes, perfection only come in love, God is love, He is perfect in all His ways, if we could walk in love perfectly we would also become incorruptible life. We will gain incorruptible life in having our faith perfected into God's love.

***Heb.5:9 Having been made perfect, he became to all of those who obey him the author of eternal salvation.***

***James 1:12 Blessed is the man who endures temptation, for when he has been approved, he will receive the crown of life, which the Lord promised to those who love him.***

***1Pet.4:1 Forasmuch then as Christ suffered for us in the flesh, arm yourselves also with the same mind; for he who has suffered in the flesh has ceased from sin;***

***4:2 that you no longer should live the rest of your time in the flesh for the lusts of men, but for the will of God.***

### **Desisting From Sin**

For us to be completely translated into love, which, Jesus Christ has become too us; being he is the exact representation of God in a perfect image of His very being, we must suffer in our flesh, but why?

***1 Peter 4:1 Forasmuch then as Christ suffered for us in the flesh, arm yourselves also with the same mind; for he who has suffered in the flesh has ceased from sin.***

How can a person cease from sin when we know that all of us have sin?

***1John 1:8 If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us.***

***1John 1:10 If we say that we haven't sinned, we make him a liar, and his word is not in us.***

***1John 3:6 Whoever remains in him doesn't sin. Whoever sins hasn't seen him, neither knows him.***

We cannot cease from sin in our own righteousness, that is, we cannot be sinless without being in Christ Jesus. The dichotomy is we are both; in sin from our fallen flesh, but sinless in Christ Jesus. The very thing which seems to be the undoing of us is the making us new each day and perfecting our faith in suffering in this manner, and here is why.

In Christ Jesus we are sinless, because there is no judgment of the Old Law against him because he is life, and life has no judgment of God righteousness against it. So in Christ Jesus we cease from sin, because we are a part of his body the head of which is holy, so is all the body.

But at the same time we have a sinful flesh warring against life in Jesus Christ, when the Spirit conquers the flesh it kills it and the life of Christ Jesus works in us, but the opposite is also true, sometimes the flesh kills the Spirit in us, and we walk in the flesh being lead by it fruits or desires.

Sin produces death, but it is also a lack of faith in us, why? Because faith is a gift of God's Holy Spirit, and where the flesh wins out it kills the Spirit so we lose our faith and sink into the sea of wickedness as Peter himself experience in his flesh while walking upon the water.

***Isaiah 57:20 But the wicked are like the troubled sea; for it can't rest, and its waters cast up mire and dirt.***

This death is as real to a brother of Christ as death is to our flesh, although as already mention this whole process goes on unseen by fleshly eyes, but not to the eyes of the spirit world opposed too God.

*2Cor.1:10 who delivered us out of so great a death, and does deliver; on whom we have set our hope that he will also still deliver us;*

*1:11 you also helping together on our behalf by your supplication; that, for the gift bestowed on us by means of many, thanks may be given by many persons on your behalf.*

*Romans 8:6 For the mind of the flesh is death, but the mind of the Spirit is life and peace;*

*1 Corinthians 4:9 For, I think that God has displayed us, the apostles, last of all, like men sentenced to death. For we are made a spectacle to the world, both to angels and men.*

*1 Corinthians 11:26 For as often as you eat this bread and drink this cup, you proclaim the Lord's death until he comes.*

*2 Corinthians 4:11 For we who live are always delivered to death for Jesus' sake, that the life also of Jesus may be revealed in our mortal flesh.*

*2 Corinthians 4:12 So then death works in us, but life in you.*

*Romans 8:36 Even as it is written, "For your sake we are killed all day long. We were accounted as sheep for the slaughter." {Psalm 44:22}*

Doubt is a lack of faith, and sin is also, so in a death like state, one is forced into giving up their soul into the hands of God to save them out of our sins-death-like state to the spirit, caused by a lack of faith. Now this is the faith that conquers the world, God is good and righteous Father even though we be condemned by our sins, He is faithful even in our sin and death, delivering us time, and time again perfecting our faith in His perfect love as our Father.

Through this amazing process we come to understand God is always good and always love, this in turn perfects our faith in the goodness of God, in this we cease from sin,

because we walk more and more in Christ Jesus love where there is no longer sin.

The type of faith is the type of faith Abraham had that made him perfect in God's love obeying anything God ask him to do, including the killing of the very promise of God to him, his own son Isaac. Believing good when there is only bad in us proves that we are willing to give up our lives in our sinful flesh each day to love God. Satan uses this guilt when the flesh kills the Spirit in trying to destroy our faith and love for God. Satan claims God is evil and cannot forgive our sins because we willfully sinned against God, and because we are seemingly dead spiritually is proof of God displeasure. But Satan is proven to be a liar in the undeserved kindness of God, Christ Jesus.

Jesus must have thought for a moment when Satan had the power to take him where ever he wanted to tempt him, that God was displeased in him, but fearlessly in claimed God as righteousness and Satan a liar. We to must declare Christ Jesus righteousness and not our own when it flesh kills the Spirit and then wait on the Lord goodness to restore us into Christ Jesus by His Holy Spirit. Nonetheless, God is always good and cannot do evil he cannot forget his promises to us even in our sin, but how can that be?

Simply put we must believe though we sin we are not a sinners, Christ Jesus took that condemnation for us so God looks at Christ Jesus and His righteousness not our sin, which is no more, it is dead and gone in Christ Jesus. We can not look at being deserving or not deserving we must stay in the undeserved kindness of Christ Jesus, which is an irrevocable promise of God.

This love of God is so great that its depth in beyond any human understanding, we cannot claim it as a rule that allows us to freely sin against God, nor can we listen to the Devil telling us God is evil waiting to punish us with the righteousness of the law.

We can only receive something so great that we cannot imagine God could actually forgive us in so many ways that it perfects our faith into pure gold not perishable by human reasoning by sins law.

***1Pet.:3 Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who according to his great mercy became our father again to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead,***

*1:4 to an incorruptible and undefiled inheritance that doesn't fade away,  
reserved in Heaven for you,  
1:5 who by the power of God are guarded through faith for a salvation ready  
to be revealed in the last time.  
1:6 Wherein you greatly rejoice, though now for a little while, if need be, you  
have been put to grief in various trials,  
1:7 that the proof of your faith, which is more precious than gold that perishes  
even though it is tested by fire, may be found to result in praise, glory, and  
honor at the revelation of Jesus Christ--*

*Rom. 7:22 For I delight in God's law after the inward man,*

*7:23 but I see a different law in my members, warring against the law of my  
mind, and bringing me into captivity under the law of sin which is in my  
members.*

*7:24 What a wretched man I am! Who will deliver me out of the body of this  
death?*

*7:25 I thank God through Jesus Christ, our Lord! So then with the mind, I  
myself serve God's law, but with the flesh, the sin's law.*

### Fixing Eyes on Christ Jesus

*Colossians 3:1 If then you were raised together with Christ, seek the things that  
are above, where Christ is, seated on the right hand of God.*

Our understanding of how we suffer and why we suffer in Christ Jesus fix's our eyes on him. Running a race and looking for ways out of the race will not bring one to the finish line. Satan and his power of darkness is a god of confusion, so where he gets a hold of God's word he confuses it with purpose of destroying spiritual lives in Christ Jesus.

*Matt.4:5 Then the devil took him into the holy city. He set him on the pinnacle  
of the temple,*

*4:6 and said to him, "If you are the Son of God, throw yourself down, for it is  
written, 'He will put his angels in charge of you.' and, 'On their hands they will  
bear you up, so that you don't dash your foot against a stone.'" {Psalm 91:11-12}*

Although Satan uses the “holy temple to tempt Jesus; Christ didn't fall into the trap of the Devil in making an example of faith into a rock solid law so he could jump testing God that He would keep his written word to him. No! And for those who are mature in Christ Jesus they will not become resentful when happy stories told by a ministers to make people feel better to support their financial needs does not come true.

Instead they will understand that faith is defined in love, and love is defined under test; if we are going to love God despite our test. Nor will a mature Christian become jealous of other seemingly blessed in some material way by their test. Love does not compare it simply knows God is good, and evil does not come from Him and our real rewards awaits us in heaven.

***1 Peter 1:4 to an incorruptible and undefiled inheritance that doesn't fade away, reserved in Heaven for you.***

***Ephesians 1:18 having the eyes of your hearts{TR reads "understanding" instead of "hearts"} enlightened, that you may know what is the hope of his calling, and what are the riches of the glory of his inheritance in the saints.***

Suffering unseen from the approval of men is almost impossible, however, too suffer ones whole life time unseen by the approval of men takes real faith in God. But beyond faith it takes a deep love for all that our God is. Yes, love for God, in all He allows into our lives, trusting that nothing within our life is haphazard.

***Rom.8:24 For we were saved in hope, but hope that is seen is not hope. For who hopes for that which he sees?***

***8:25 But if we hope for that which we don't see, we wait for it with patience.***

Trusting that we are foreordain for God purpose; chosen from the foundation of our earth to bring God glory; in knowing God as love, but how is this possible?

Because there is no other logical human reason why? But that God is love; that He would choose such wretched being to glorify His name in demonstrating His undeserved kindness for the fallen human race.

***1Cor.1:25 Because the foolishness of God is wiser than men, and the weakness of God is stronger than men.***



***Rom.7:18 For I know that in me, that is, in my flesh, dwells no good thing. For desire is present with me, but I don't find it doing that which is good.***

***Rom. 8:7 because the mind of the flesh is hostile towards God; for it is not subject to God's law, neither indeed can it be.***

***8:8 Those who are in the flesh can't please God.***

Truly grasping the depth and height of God's love mean understanding the word grace, or undeserved kindness. Without a clear focus of God's love through His undeserved kindness too us we cannot suffer in Christ Jesus, nor even understand why we are suffering?

***Rom. 7:24 What a wretched man I am! Who will deliver me out of the body of this death?***

***7:25 I thank God through Jesus Christ, our Lord! So then with the mind, I myself serve God's law, but with the flesh, the sin's law.***

***1Pet.4:1 Forasmuch then as Christ suffered for us in the flesh, arm yourselves also with the same mind; for he who has suffered in the flesh has ceased from sin;***

***4:2 that you no longer should live the rest of your time in the flesh for the lusts of men, but for the will of God.***

### **Humility in God's Love**

Translating ones language into another language is not easy work, translating our sinful condition from law into love is humanly impossible. God is performing something so great that it stops the flesh cold, and kills all haughtiness of its sinful power over us in pride.

Every day of our lives as humans we are convicted of our sins by God's law, we must pay the price for our sins which is death. Death marches forward from Adam too us; we daily lose those we love in death.

***Romans 5:17 For if by the trespass of the one, death reigned through the one; so much more will those who receive the abundance of grace and of the gift of righteousness reign in life through the one, Jesus Christ.***

Sin claims it conviction of us in concrete reality by death, one cannot deny the truth we all must face. To remove death; sin has to be removed from us, but we are not worthy to have sin removed from us according to the conviction of God's righteous laws. But if heaven and earth could be removed than God's law, or the conviction us of our sins could be removed from us also.

***Rom.8:22 For we know that the whole creation groans and travails in pain together until now.***

***8:23 Not only so, but ourselves also, who have the first fruits of the Spirit, even we ourselves groan within ourselves, waiting for adoption, the redemption of our body.***

In humility we acknowledge that in God's eyes we are wretched in our sinful condition.

***Isaiah 1:18 "Come now, and let us reason together," says Yahweh: "Though your sins be as scarlet, they shall be as white as snow. Though they be red like crimson, they shall be as wool.***

***Isaiah 59:2 but your iniquities have separated between you and your God, and your sins have hidden his face from you, so that he will not hear.***

***Rom.7:22 For I delight in God's law after the inward man, 7:23 but I see a different law in my members, warring against the law of my mind, and bringing me into captivity under the law of sin which is in my members.***

***7:24 What a wretched man I am! Who will deliver me out of the body of this death?***

***7:25 I thank God through Jesus Christ, our Lord! So then with the mind, I myself serve God's law, but with the flesh, the sin's law.***

Haughtiness says: "I am as good as the next guy, my sins are no better, or worst than his so what is the big deal? I obey the laws and God's laws". And God says you are right in your human judgment of yourselves; comparing yourself against yourself or by others, but my ways are not your ways or my thoughts yours.

***Isaiah 55:8 For my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways, says Yahweh.***

***Isaiah 55:9 For as the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways, and my thoughts than your thoughts.***

God judges by eternal life because He is life and there is no death within Him, death is an enemy of God, one that He will brought to nothing. So human comparison through any means religious or otherwise are death to God's judgments. God does not take a piece of mankind sin and make it into something tolerable too Him, no! God take a new lump something without sin and provides it too us making us a part of it so we become a new in life free of sin.

***Dan.2:44 In the days of those kings shall the God of heaven set up a kingdom which shall never be destroyed, nor shall its sovereignty be left to another people; but it shall break in pieces and consume all these kingdoms, and it shall stand forever.***

***2:45 Because you saw that a stone was cut out of the mountain without hands, and that it broke in pieces the iron, the brass, the clay, the silver, and the gold; the great God has made known to the king what shall happen hereafter:***

***Mark 2:21 No one sews a piece of unshrunk cloth on an old garment, or else the patch shrinks and the new tears away from the old, and a worse hole is made.***

***Mark 2:22 No one puts new wine into old wineskins, or else the new wine will burst the skins, and the wine pours out, and the skins will be destroyed; but they put new wine into fresh wineskins."***

***2 Peter 3:13 But, according to his promise, we look for new heavens and a new earth, in which righteousness dwells.***

***1 Corinthians 5:8 Therefore let us keep the feast, not with old yeast, neither with the yeast of malice and wickedness, but with the unleavened bread of sincerity and truth.***

Yes, life eternal cannot have sin, God makes us new in Christ Jesus the sinless bread of God. We become a part of his life, Christ Jesus is Life, God rewarded him with incorruptible life, he became The Life the bread of live for the human race.

***John 6:32 Jesus therefore said to them, "Most certainly, I tell you, it wasn't Moses who gave you the bread out of heaven, but my Father gives you the true bread out of heaven.***

***John 6:33 For the bread of God is that which comes down out of heaven, and gives life to the world."***

***1 Corinthians 5:8 Therefore let us keep the feast, not with old yeast, neither with the yeast of malice and wickedness, but with the unleavened bread of sincerity and truth.***

Here we now see how God removes the old heavens and earth and replaces them with the New heavens and earth. Yes, keeping his perfect words:

### **Removing Heaven and Earth for Love**

***Matt.5:17 "Don't think that I came to destroy the law or the prophets. I didn't come to destroy, but to fulfill.***

***5:18 For most certainly, I tell you, until heaven and earth pass away, not even one smallest letter{literally, iota} or one tiny pen stroke{or, serif} shall in any way pass away from the law, until all things are accomplished.***

***5:19 Whoever, therefore, shall break one of these least commandments, and teach others to do so, shall be called least in the Kingdom of Heaven; but whoever shall do and teach them shall be called great in the Kingdom of Heaven.***

The appointed time had come for God in removing the Old Law that ruled over the nation of Israel as their heavens, Christ Jesus fulfilled it and set it aside, faith in God's love removed what could not be removed by any humans means the Law. If humans could remove the heavens and earth they would than have hope for salvation by their own good works.

Now that the Law was removed our sins were not accounted against us provided we accepted God's free gift too us, and what is that, Jesus Christ or God's grace, meaning His undeserved kindness. Satan was soundly defeated, death was defeated, and Life ruled over mankind again.

***Luke 10:18 He said to them, "I saw Satan having fallen like lightning from heaven.***

But one must remember we have to accept the one and only name given among men to get saved by and its power of righteousness in removing the righteousness of the Old Law; the name of Christ Jesus, but why? His life replaced the righteousness of the old law removing its punishment from us. None of us could remove our sins not unless we could somehow remove the Old Law, or heavens and earth, if not we must live in death no matter how much we obeyed the Old Law.

God gives us the Life of His Son by imputing his righteousness to us this means we are dead to sin under the Old Law, but we are alive in Jesus Christ according to the new law of love.

Suffering then in ourselves is of no value in God's eyes, we are just suffering under sin's law and according to it, we deserved to suffer for our sins. But in Christ Jesus because he is sinless and has proven his faithfulness unto death; he does not deserve to suffer or die because he cannot be convicted of sin.

We are given this gift of God's love, it is an irrevocable promise of God because it is a promise based on faith in God and His love for us in His Son Christ Jesus.

***Romans 11:29 For the gifts and the calling of God are irrevocable.***

***Matthew 16:21 From that time, Jesus began to show his disciples that he must go to Jerusalem and suffer many things from the elders, chief priests, and scribes, and be killed, and the third day be raised up.***

The gift we hold inside our hearts is the life of Jesus Christ we suffer because we belong to him, so we are marked with the Holy Spirit of our Father Jehovah God. Those teaching the law or those teaching doctrine convicted Jesus Christ of sin, how much more so will they do so to his followers?

***Romans 8:17 and if children, then heirs; heirs of God, and joint heirs with Christ; if indeed we suffer with him, that we may also be glorified with him.***

***Matt. 10:25 It is enough for the disciple that he be like his teacher, and the servant like his lord. If they have called the master of the house Beelzebub, how much more those of his household!***

***John 1:4 In him was life, and the life was the light of men.***

***John 3:15 that whoever believes in him should not perish, but have eternal life.***

***Matthew 5:14 You are the light of the world. A city located on a hill can't be hidden.***

Sin and guilt is the tool of the Devil to hold people in bondage, Christ Jesus is freedom, life and sinlessness, the Devil has no hold on him, but where he can use one of Christ Jesus brothers sins against them, he will destroy their faith in Christ Jesus sinless body. And this is why discipline should not be so harsh by those in Christ that a brother born in love is destroyed in the discipline of a group. This too is another persecution that has been effectively used by Satan throughout the history of Christ Jesus brothers on earth.

In other words, when we step out of the body of Christ under self-justification we have no standing against forces of evil. How much more so someone put out of Christ Jesus by the power of the Holy Spirit through brothers in charge of spiritual lives.

But when we stand in Christ Jesus righteousness we have power beyond human sin and are strengthen in combating evil in ourselves and against the spirit world working through willing humans. Christ Jesus righteousness is so powerful that not even the demons can stand against him; so who is going to convicted the Son of Living God of Sin? Whereby that righteousness is past on too us, not by our good works, but God righteous love towards his Son, who can stand against us?

***1Cor.12:3 Therefore I make known to you that no man speaking by God's Spirit says, "Jesus is accursed." No one can say, "Jesus is Lord," but by the Holy Spirit.***

***1Cor.10:3 For though we walk in the flesh, we don't wage war according to the flesh;***

***10:4 for the weapons of our warfare are not of the flesh, but mighty before  
God to the throwing down of strongholds,  
10:5 throwing down imaginations and every high thing that is exalted against  
the knowledge of God, and bringing every thought into captivity to the  
obedience of Christ;  
10:6 and being in readiness to avenge all disobedience, when your obedience  
will be made full.  
10:7 Do you look at things only as they appear in front of your face? If  
anyone trusts in himself that he is Christ's, let him consider this again with  
himself, that, even as he is Christ's, so also we are Christ's.***

Nothing in heaven or earth can unseat the power of our Lord Jesus Christ and we are a part of him sharing what he is because we are part of his body. This is the faith we must possess to overcome this world not in our own good works or if we are worthy enough, but in believing in the name of Christ Jesus.

***Matthew 9:6 But that you may know that the Son of Man has authority on earth to forgive sins..." (then he said to the paralytic), "Get up, and take up your mat, and go up to your house."***

***Matthew 16:27 For the Son of Man will come in the glory of his Father with his angels, and then he will render to everyone according to his deeds.***

### **Sinning Against Righteous Blood**

When a man is wrongly convicted and it is then found out, payment must be made for the wrong done him. This is part of the law and it in the workings of justice too restore one to their rightful place in society. Where a person persecutes one of Christ brothers by law, which is no longer valid against them they must be judged with equal force of the same law and its judgment.

***Matt.7:1 Don't judge, so that you won't be judged.  
7:2 For with whatever judgment you judge, you will be judged; and with  
whatever measure you measure, it will be measured to you.  
7:3 Why do you see the speck that is in your brother's eye, but don't consider  
the beam that is in your own eye?  
7:4 Or how will you tell your brother, 'Let me remove the speck from your  
eye;' and behold, the beam is in your own eye?***

***7:5 You hypocrite! First remove the beam out of your own eye, and then you can see clearly to remove the speck out of your brother's eye.***

Christ Jesus clearly stated it would be those wheeling the power of the Law that would persecuted him and his brothers, but why? Simply put the law gives them the seeming right to judge others as sinful or righteous, subsequently, a misstep under law requires a payment by the law in punishment. Many Christian's throughout the history of Christianity have been persecuted, and killed by those claiming Christ Jesus as their king, while wheeling the power of law destroying the lives of Christ Jesus brothers.

***Revelation 6:10 They cried with a loud voice, saying, "How long, Master, the holy and true, until you judge and avenge our blood on those who dwell on the earth?"***

These brothers of Christ Jesus righteous blood must be found in justice by God; God has declared them righteous in the blood of His own Son Christ Jesus, though sin is present with them in their fallen flesh, it is not with God, who has removed their sins in Christ Jesus. So those stating God is injustice in this according to law, and not love come under the very judgment they put upon Christ Jesus brothers. Fairness and justice requires God by His own righteous standard to kill the whole human race, but He withholds this justice in favor of love, so then who are we to tell God that Christ Jesus brothers are not sinless because God has place them in His Son very life given as a gift too them? Yet, this is the way among those promoting laws of their group doctrines, or for that matter, whatever other seemingly righteous standard used in persecuting Christ Jesus brothers on earth.

***Psalms 140:12 I know that Yahweh will maintain the cause of the afflicted, and justice for the needy.***

***Proverbs 18:5 To be partial to the faces of the wicked is not good, nor to deprive the innocent of justice.***

***Proverbs 21:3 To do righteousness and justice is more acceptable to Yahweh than sacrifice.***



***Isaiah 1:27 Zion shall be redeemed with justice, and her converts with righteousness.***

***Isaiah 42:1 "Behold, my servant, whom I uphold; my chosen, in whom my soul delights-- I have put my Spirit on him. He will bring justice to the nations.***

Those in authority during Christ Jesus day judged the righteous blood of Christ Jesus as a sinner. The Law then came upon them in full force, whereas they had killed God's prophets in past times without God destroying the nations. This time when they destroyed the Son of God, who was sinless, according to God's righteousness Law, the Law must set matters right in restoring Christ Jesus to life giving him the reward of righteous blood before God. Because Jesus was sinless those persons judging him were judging their own sins in their hearts reflected by their judgment of righteous blood. In other words, there can be no judgment against righteous blood because there is no fault found in it against God's righteous law. Subsequently, those doing so are asking God to pervert His own righteousness for their unrighteousness.

All that is left in judging righteous blood is our own sin! Justice requires our own conviction because we have judged and convicted someone unrighteously by our own sins.

***Matt.7:1 "Don't judge, so that you won't be judged.***

***7:2 For with whatever judgment you judge, you will be judged; and with whatever measure you measure, it will be measured to you.***

Thus, the whole nation of Israel came to its legal end in God's eyes, it was no longer found in a valid contract with God in a covenant position. God was no longer under legal obligation to uphold His end of the contract, so the nation was brought to the ground by the Roman empire finding their judgment of righteous blood was really their own wicked judgment in which they had convicted Christ Jesus of and destroyed him by.

### **Judgment of the World by Righteous Blood**

Jesus now at God's right hand as King of Kings has his righteous blood still upon the earth where all nations come into judgment by the treatment of him by his

body upon earth, his righteousness blood flows through to each members by his body through God's own will, which governs the body of Christ Jesus. That is, Christ Jesus and his body were created for the will of God. God has put each member into the death of Christ Jesus, blotting out their sin forever, that is, they have no past sins under law found against them in Christ Jesus. Thus, when one judges them according to the laws of man, or religious doctrines they bring their own judgment upon themselves, and the group upholding the rules. Furthermore, we find all the blood of God's holy ones the saints found in Babylon the Great false religion when God judges the world.

This is why Jesus spoke of those not of his sheep fold as thieves plundering the flock. Yes, they would take up the judgment of the law of their groups doctrine, judging the brothers of Christ Jesus as not meeting the standards of their group. These judgments persecute the brothers of Christ Jesus. But at the same time those enforcing the rules imagining they are doing as scared service for God are judging themselves. unwittingly they are judging righteous blood, that of Jesus Christ, whom physical eyes cannot see or understand; flowing into his own body by God's perfect will for the body of Christ Jesus.

Not imagining for a moment that God will not bless their judgment based on righteous laws including the Law of Moses, they find themselves under the same judgment of God's righteous laws condemning all humans as unrighteous sinner. Thus, instead of being found under the New covenant of love, which removes the wrath of God through His Law, subsequently, they are condemned to death by it judgment. But it goes further, in imagining God will uphold their judgment they are found drunk with the holy blood of God own children.

***Revelation 16:19 The great city was divided into three parts, and the cities of the nations fell. Babylon the great was remembered in the sight of God, to give to her the cup of the wine of the fierceness of his wrath.***

***Revelation 17:6 I saw the woman drunken with the blood of the saints, and with the blood of the martyrs of Jesus. When I saw her, I wondered with great amazement.***

***Revelation 18:24 In her was found the blood of prophets and of saints, and of all who have been slain on the earth."***

## **The Harshness of Law Denying Water**

Those wheeling the law refused to give Christ brothers a drink of Christ Jesus, feeling justified in their denial, foolishly believing God in His own cruelty would deny His enemy a drink of water accounting God as evil by law found in their own hearts. So harsh have these become by so called righteous laws they destroy the very lives of Christ brothers. They have blinded themselves, through a principal of law as scared denying the very basic provision of human life to the sinless saint of God.

Their own unrighteousness goes so deep in self-righteousness they fear not even God's holy ones upon earth. Judging and condemning all things within their own lives by law of a group, church, or government, or otherwise, they trample upon holy blood as mere dirt under their feet, not imagining according to their judgments they are sinning against God Himself.

***John 16:1 "These things have I spoken to you, so that you wouldn't be caused to stumble.***

***16:2 They will put you out of the synagogues. Yes, the time comes that whoever kills you will think that he offers service to God.***

***16:3 They will do these things{TR adds "to you"} because they have not known the Father, nor me.***

***16:4 But I have told you these things, so that when the time comes, you may remember that I told you about them. I didn't tell you these things from the beginning, because I was with you.***

These persecutors judge personalities, found within their doctrines or laws forming them into a certain type of personality accepted by their group. In fact, they have formed Christ Jesus into a specific type of personality also by their beliefs of their group. Subsequently, they judge Christ brothers by “personality” not realizing they are dealing with scared blood because they can do otherwise, being under works of laws, they refuse elemental kindness of the world to Christ Jesus brothers.

***Matt.25:38 When did we see you as a stranger, and take you in; or naked, and clothe you?***

***25:39 When did we see you sick, or in prison, and come to you?'***

***25:40 "The King will answer them, 'Most certainly I tell you, inasmuch as you did it to one of the least of these my brothers{The word for "brothers" here may be also correctly translated "brothers and sisters" or "siblings."}, you did it to me.'***

What could possibly blind people from knowing Christ Jesus brothers? Not willing to perform even the smallest kindness towards them; given even to the worst convicts on earth? Moreover, when ever group on earth claiming to be Christian say they are Christ brothers? Simply put, it is the rules of their group that blinds them to human compassion, and love for Christ Jesus brothers, neither can they offer refreshing water or food of Christ Jesus to his brothers by practicing law, that type of bread is gone in Christ Jesus, which is found too be yeast, producing sin and judgment, so they kill Holy Spirit of God, instead feeding Christ brothers law through their doctrine, denying them the very person they claim to love, and serve Christ Jesus. Much the same as the rich man and Lazarus. Where the rich man lived a life of luxury upon the earth protected by God's righteous laws, but at the same time denying the beggar even the slightest mercy; so to will those threat Christ brothers, by weed-like Christians claiming God's love in Christ Jesus, while denying Christ brothers food, and water found in Christ by law driven doctrines performed by works of law.

***Luke 16:19 "Now there was a certain rich man, and he was clothed in purple and fine linen, living in luxury every day.***

***16:20 A certain beggar, named Lazarus, was laid at his gate, full of sores,  
16:21 and desiring to be fed with the crumbs that fell from the rich man's table. Yes, even the dogs came and licked his sores.***

***16:22 It happened that the beggar died, and that he was carried away by the angels to Abraham's bosom. The rich man also died, and was buried.***

***16:23 In Hades{or, Hell}, he lifted up his eyes, being in torment, and saw Abraham far off, and Lazarus at his bosom.***

***16:24 He cried and said, 'Father Abraham, have mercy on me, and send Lazarus, that he may dip the tip of his finger in water, and cool my tongue! For I am in anguish in this flame.'***

***16:25 "But Abraham said, 'Son, remember that you, in your lifetime, received your good things, and Lazarus, in like manner, bad things. But now here he is comforted and you are in anguish.***

*16:26 Besides all this, between us and you there is a great gulf fixed, that those who want to pass from here to you are not able, and that none may cross over from there to us.'*

*16:27 "He said, 'I ask you therefore, father, that you would send him to my father's house;*

*16:28 for I have five brothers, that he may testify to them, so they won't also come into this place of torment.'*

*16:29 "But Abraham said to him, 'They have Moses and the prophets. Let them listen to them.'*

*16:30 "He said, 'No, father Abraham, but if one goes to them from the dead, they will repent.'*

*16:31 "He said to him, 'If they don't listen to Moses and the prophets, neither will they be persuaded if one rises from the dead.'"*

*Matt.25:41 Then he will say also to those on the left hand, 'Depart from me, you cursed, into the eternal fire which is prepared for the devil and his angels;*

*25:42 for I was hungry, and you didn't give me food to eat; I was thirsty, and you gave me no drink;*

*25:43 I was a stranger, and you didn't take me in; naked, and you didn't clothe me; sick, and in prison, and you didn't visit me.'*

*25:44 "Then they will also answer, saying, 'Lord, when did we see you hungry, or thirsty, or a stranger, or naked, or sick, or in prison, and didn't help you?'*

*25:45 "Then he will answer them, saying, 'Most certainly I tell you, inasmuch as you didn't do it to one of the least of these, you didn't do it to me.'*

This type of persecution is one of the greatest persecution a person can under go through in this life. Those claiming the bread of life, and yet handing a brother of Christ a stone or a serpent to destroy them with malice under the wrath of the law is cruel, and callous punishment by those claiming a God of love.

The refreshing waters of life in Jesus Christ denied by the rule of law of doctrines by those put in charge of spiritual lives there can be no greater injustice found on earth. But what these persecutors thinking they have rendered a sacred service according to the rule of law has not gone unnoticed by the God of justice.

*Matt.25:46 These will go away into eternal punishment, but the righteous into eternal life."*

***John 16:1 "These things have I spoken to you, so that you wouldn't be caused to stumble.***

***16:2 They will put you out of the synagogues. Yes, the time comes that whoever kills you will think that he offers service to God.***

***16:3 They will do these things{TR adds "to you"} because they have not known the Father, nor me.***

***16:4 But I have told you these things, so that when the time comes, you may remember that I told you about them. I didn't tell you these things from the beginning, because I was with you.***

### **Suffering for Righteousness**

Suffering for Christ Jesus is suffering for righteousness, but is it worth it? The word "worth" does not come into play for those in Christ Jesus, who are led by God's Spirit, worth is a matter of law under merit, and so what does that mean?

When one looks at a tree its very fiber makes it a tree, no one sits and wonders if this is a tree? When a person walks in love, it is the fiber of the tree we are grafted into, it is not a matter of our worth or is it worth being in the tree?

Those with the love of God in them; suffering is their life on this earth as proof of being part of the true vine of Christ Jesus. Their worth is the vine, which is also the fine pearl, and it is the fiber of the personality Christ in them. Whereas those walking by flesh or the rule of the law, they see it as a matter of trade off for payment with God. It is not a matter of love, love does not count the cost, where law demands a payment for suffering.

Those counting cost miss the undeserved kindness of God, and the highest honor ever given to men of flesh that of suffering for Christ Jesus righteousness sake. Those suffering for righteousness sake do not do it for payment; their payment already been paid them in having the life of Christ Jesus in them; their reward is God's love, and their humility is found in God's undeserved kindness too them as sinners by the personality of Christ Jesus working through them, what else can they do but rejoice in their suffering?

Trying to exact payment by legal law is wicked, it claims God Himself as evil; that He cannot be trusted to do good without being made too by legal contract. Moreover, those placing trust in doctrine of men will find themselves deeply disappointed when the fire of God's judgment comes upon the unrighteous. Let us here define unrighteousness in God's word to us. We are all unrighteous if we are not found in Christ Jesus righteousness, which declares us righteous.

***Matt.7:22 Many will tell me in that day, 'Lord, Lord, didn't we prophesy in your name, in your name cast out demons, and in your name do many mighty works?'***

***7:23 Then I will tell them, 'I never knew you. Depart from me, you who work iniquity.'***

***7:24 "Everyone therefore who hears these words of mine, and does them, I will liken him to a wise man, who built his house on a rock.***

***7:25 The rain came down, the floods came, and the winds blew, and beat on that house; and it didn't fall, for it was founded on the rock.***

***7:26 Everyone who hears these words of mine, and doesn't do them will be like a foolish man, who built his house on the sand.***

***7:27 The rain came down, the floods came, and the winds blew, and beat on that house; and it fell--and great was its fall."***

***7:28 It happened, when Jesus had finished saying these things, that the multitudes were astonished at his teaching,***

***7:29 for he taught them with authority, and not like the scribes.***

***1Cor. 3:11 For no one can lay any other foundation than that which has been laid, which is Jesus Christ.***

***3:12 But if anyone builds on the foundation with gold, silver, costly stones, wood, hay, or stubble;***

***3:13 each man's work will be revealed. For the Day will declare it, because it is revealed in fire; and the fire itself will test what sort of work each man's work is.***

***3:14 If any man's work remains which he built on it, he will receive a reward.***

***3:15 If any man's work is burned, he will suffer loss, but he himself will be saved, but as through fire.***

***3:16 Don't you know that you are a temple of God, and that God's Spirit lives in you?***

The suffering of Christ Jesus is not an option based upon where we are in the stream of time it is a fact of being marked with the Spirit of God in a world under the power of Satan the Devil who seeks to destroy all that love God. But in this suffering life will be found for the entire creations, it is the very plan of God for the good of all those loving Him, to be set free from the corruption of sin and its thinking by the suffering of Christ Jesus body.

In this suffering for love God is perfecting and restoring the creations so all will be made new in God's love; nations will be heal, and sin removed from the human race. All death, and suffering sin has caused will be undone under God's love, eternal life restored too those loving God, no more sickness, disease, or pain, will plague the human race; for God's loving kindness will rule the heavens and earth.

The painful operation of death working in us will have ended and all the loving kindness of mans rule will have vanished from the earth as a fading flower falls from the vine. Eternal incorruptible life will be the King that rules over us, we will hear no painful cry's for help, or tears of those bereaved in death.

How does on place a worth on something so great as God's love? How does one say you are worthy Oh Lord to receive all the glory and power for you alone were found worthy in heaven and upon earth to take God's righteousness and translate us into love for the human race, how can we thank you Father for your loving kindness in the blood of your Son Christ Jesus?

As this document stated from its start too suffer unseen by human eyes is extreme persecution. Moreover, suffering at the hands of those claiming Christ Jesus by rules of laws blinding them to loving the body of Christ Jesus is inhuman.

Here we see the war still raging into modern times, the flesh warring with the Spirit of God, the flesh looking to those with credentials, and position in false religion over looking those having God's Spirit in the body of Christ Jesus. Moreover, suffering at the hands of Satan world as though Christ brothers don't exist on earth. Some have conjectured that this is because of their humility of Christ Jesus in them as his brothers, that is, in not making a show of their position in Christ Jesus, but such false thinking by the sinful flesh under law is nothing more than a justification for persecution of Christ Jesus brothers. When it is



nothing more than complete neglect in not seeking God, and His ways in love that blinds them to showing any kindness. Whereas, some do at great cost, ministering to Christ brothers, even if it means their death because they live by faith, and love for Christ Jesus.

***Matt.25:46 These will go away into eternal punishment, but the righteous into eternal life."***

The goats not understanding the sins of Christ brothers are not found in Christ Jesus, and that their Father has declared them righteous by the blood of Christ Jesus. In doing so God removed the Law's judgment against them. They too are sinless in God's eyes, yet, they have sins of the flesh, God had not remove their sin only the Law convicting them of their sins.

So those enforcing the law against Christ brothers are judging God, and His Son Christ Jesus as unrighteous. Unwittingly, God allows Christ brothers to stumble in their sins of their fleshly bodies at times causing a refinement of His people on earth. Those under law cannot help but persecute Christ brothers when they stumble, it is the nature of the sinful flesh to feel superior and judge harshly. The flesh must justify itself, and it does so by comparing its own ways and righteousness against others. This creates a great sea of wickedness constantly churning up the mud of badness among the human race. There is no peace for the wicked, and when found under law's judgment all are wicked outside of Christ's body.

***Dan.11:35 Some of those who are wise shall fall, to refine them, and to purify, and to make them white, even to the time of the end; because it is yet for the time appointed.***

***Revelation 11:2 Leave out the court which is outside of the temple, and don't measure it, for it has been given to the nations. They will tread the holy city under foot for forty-two months.***

In conclusion, Christ brothers/sisters must understand the life in them is Christ Jesus, they do not exist any longer in their own will, or their flesh, they are freed of sin's law, in Christ Jesus. Thus, their persecution comes because of the life of Christ Jesus found in them. The wicked spirit world, or fallen angels see the mark of Christ in them, thus, they are attacked because of Christ Jesus' life in them.

And at the same time, they are attack by humans used by wicked spirit persons. Thus, they find themselves judged and trampling upon by these judgments of law.

Some of these will repent from their evil ways and accept the undeserved kindness in Christ Jesus appreciating the gift of having their own sins removed, and the judgment of their sins remembered no more by God's undeserved kindness in Jesus Christ, freeing them from the cruse of the law.

In staying under Christ undeserved kindness the life of Christ life works through us providing us with spiritual weapons for warfare to withstand constant harassment by the demons through men. Out side of that life of Jesus Christ we are nothing more than flesh, and flesh cannot stand against wicked spirit force in heavenly places.

In all of this we must suffer for Christ Jesus so we can desist from our sin, and be translated from the law of the flesh into God's own love, which is eternal life in Christ Jesus. Found in this state, that is, in Christ Jesus, we posses nothing upon this earth, but the life of Christ Jesus, so all our treasures are stored in heaven with Christ Jesus, none of this is seen by those of the world, the world in this case means anyone loving the world rather than God, and Christ Jesus brothers.

For us too stay in the life of Christ Jesus we must always maintain that good comes from our Heavenly Father. And that bad is because of our own fallen flesh, rather it be our own, or someone else. Claiming God as light, and not darkness by the law, but rather love, which will keep us walking in the Spirit of God.

And it is true, ones have rightly argued in the past history of God's people, God's wrath came upon those breaking His righteous laws, and His judgment was righteous, and just in doing so, we agree, but in this assumption, what is over looked is this fact ...

God was not then dealing with His Children born again by His own Holy Spirit where none their judgment of the law does not exist, nor does condemnation for their sin against God's law. Thus, God's children are free from judgment, they are in God's love, and by being in God's love they come to know that good comes from their Heaven Fathers. If, however, we see God as part love and part law mixing the two as one as false doctrine do, we are putting yeast into unfermented bread of life Christ Jesus, this doctrine ferments the whole lump.

Thus, seeing God as both light, and darkness, causing us too live in fear of both, thus, not receiving the life of Christ by either. Subsequently, leaving us unprotected from wicked spirit force set upon destroying Christ Jesus brothers upon earth.

So our battle under tests is remembering that only good comes from our Father, and Satan wants us to impute evil too our Heavenly Father, That is, tricking us too believe our Father changes like a shadow, one day love and good, the next day evil and darkness; judging us wicked according too His righteous laws. But in this we will always find that it is our own sinful flesh, and not God according too His irrevocable gift of undeserved kindness too us in Jesus Christ our life.

Though everything in our sinful flesh judges us as wicked our faith in God's promises gives us faith that only good comes too from God under trial.

We can manage this high godly standard because we have Christ Jesus righteousness life in us, this allows God to act in our behalf when we fall into our sins, which is a lack of faith. He comes along side us comforts us with a mothers love, and builds us up, removing our doubt by His love for us.

Thus, Satan and false religion accuse Christ brothers as trampling upon the undeserved kindness of Christ Jesus, but it is still a fact of our faith that walking on water cannot be performed in humans strength or terms, nor can we produce a child at 100 years of age, but in our faith we can love God, and wait upon him, and believe we are forgiven. In our faith God has removed our judgment in Christ Jesus. Although this great act of love is beyond human understanding according too the judgment of law, it is nonetheless the truth of our faith in Christ Jesus. We must have the same faith as Abraham's faith, and Peter's faith in walking on water; for us to stay on-top of the sea of wicked fallen flesh found under law churning up badness in judging, and being condemned, to conquer this world in the life of Jesus Christ.

It is true and beyond us that we do not deserve such a grand and wonderful gift of God's love in Christ Jesus too us, but He has given it too us anyway by our faith in Him; no amount of disbelief is going too make us righteous according to works of law, but belief in God's promises will make us sinless in our faith in Christ Jesus. Claiming this, is claiming the power of Christ Jesus, and his name, in this, we overcome darkness, and conquer the world.

Satan wants nothing more, then for us to try to make ourselves sinless by our own efforts through works of law, or doctrines of law in some group. In doing so, we lose the power of Christ Jesus life in us, and our spiritual battle against Satan the Devil.

***1 John 5:4 For whatever is born of God overcomes the world. This is the victory that has overcome the world: your faith.***

***1 John 5:5 Who is he who overcomes the world, but he who believes that Jesus is the Son of God?***

***Revelation 21:7 He who overcomes, I will give him these things. I will be his God, and he will be my son.***

May none of us doubt God's love, but if we do, let us know our God is faithful, and bigger than our hearts. So may the undeserved kindness of our Lord and Savior be with the Spirit you show.

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
